

PROGRAM

GENERAL OBJECTIVES

The **Title of Expert in Neurorehabilitation of the Brain Injury Surrendered** is directed preferably to medical specialized in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation who participate in the clinical care of people with acquired brain injury, or who want to dedicate themselves professionally in the future.

This program aims to promote the development of professional careers, both in the care aspect as in the scientific, incorporating the most effective diagnostic and therapeutic techniques and moving the limit of knowledge to those cases in which the available do not allow adequately solve the problems raised.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Train experts in the treatment and specialized rehabilitation of people with acquired brain injury, as well as the complications of their pathology.
- Prepare professionals with specific knowledge and skills to participate in multidisciplinary work teams, favoring the convergence of knowledge and benefiting.
- Train experts with the necessary skills to lead and coordinate multidisciplinary work teams for the comprehensive care of patients with brain injury.
- Provide these professionals with a work methodology that allows them to generate new knowledge, as well as transferring them to other professionals who put them into practice to the rest of the health device, safely and with quality assurance.

STRUCTURE

The program lasts 47 weeks, with a weekly dedication of 9 classroom hours and 26 practical classroom hours.

The different modules that make up the program are formed in parallel. Given the eminently practical nature of the proposal, all activities converge throughout the student's training program.

REQUIREMENTS

- Have the degree of Bachelor / Degree in Medicine and the specialist in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, or the corresponding receipt for its processing.
- Foreigners: to process the application it is essential to present the homologation of your medical degree and the specialist certificate.
- Have an accident and civil liability insurance for the period that covers the entire stay in our hospital. If you already have an insurance policy, it will be sufficient to provide a copy of it.
