

PROGRAM

GENERAL OBJECTIVES

The **Title of Expert in Neuropsychological Rehabilitation of the Brain Damage** is directed preferably to Psychologist that participate in the clinical attention of people with Brain Damage, or who want to dedicate themselves professionally in the future. This program aims to promote the development of professional careers, both in the care aspect as in the scientific, incorporating the most effective diagnostic and therapeutic techniques and moving the limit of knowledge to those cases in which the available do not allow adequately solve the problems raised.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Train professional psychologists / experts in clinical neuropsychology; both in the exploration and diagnosis and in the rehabilitation of patients with congenital and acquired brain damage.
- Deepen neuropsychological rehabilitation through clinical-care practice.
- Integrate the theoretical-practical knowledge of professionals in real clinical settings.

STRUCTURE

The program lasts 47 weeks, with a weekly dedication of 9 classroom hours and 26 practical classroom hours.

The different modules that make up the program are formed in parallel. Given the eminently practical nature of the proposal, all activities converge throughout the student's training program.

REQUIREMENTS

- Have the degree of Bachelor / Degree in Psychology, or the corresponding receipt for its processing.
- Foreigners: to process the application it is essential to present the homologation of your psychology certificate.
- Places are prioritized to students of the Master's Degree in Neuropsychological Rehabilitation and Cognitive Stimulation, and only in the event that any place becomes vacant, the enrollment of professionals from other postgraduate studies (master's or doctorate) in neuropsychology or related disciplines will be assessed.
- Have an accident and civil liability insurance for the period that covers the entire stay in our hospital. If you already have an insurance policy, it will be sufficient to provide a copy of it.
