



MASTER IN NEUROPSYCHOLOGICAL REHABILITATION by the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona

3ND EDITION 2027-2029

The objective of the master's degree is to train Professionals specialized in the evaluation and neuropsychological rehabilitation of people with brain damage and the child and adolescent population with neurodevelopmental disorders.

It is structured in 120 ECTS, distributed over two academic courses of which 96 ECTS correspond to practical training (2.000 hours of face-to-face practices).

Specific objectives:

- Know the main pathologies that cause brain damage or neurodevelopmental disorders and that cause neuropsychological alterations.
- Learn how to use the main instruments used in the neuropsychological evaluation of patients with brain damage or neurodevelopmental disorders.
- Design and implement neuropsychological rehabilitation programs and be able to monitor them to analyze their effectiveness.

- Acquire basic methodological skills to carry out clinical research in neuropsychological rehabilitation.
